

Baker Capital's Interxion Reports Strong 2007 Results

NEW YORK, May 1, 2008 - Interxion, a leading European provider of carrier-neutral data centers and majority owned portfolio company of Baker Capital, reported significant revenue and adjusted EBITDA growth in 2007. Interxion's 2007 Annual Report and an overview of key performance metrics in 2007 are available on its website.

Highlights of Interxion's performance in 2007 include:

- Revenue increase of 36% to €101.4 million (US\$148.1 million) in 2007
- Adjusted EBITDA increase of 112% to €27.9 million (US\$40.7 million) in 2007
- Adjusted EBITDA margin increase to 27.5% in 2007 vs. 17.6% in 2006
- Operating profit of €5.5 million (US\$8.0 million) in 2007 vs. operating loss of €2.4 million (US\$3.5 million) in 2006.

Interxion also implemented the first phase of its major expansion program in 2007, increasing the amount of equipped space in its data centers by approximately 6,800 m² (approximately 73,000 ft²). This expansion included new equipped space in Paris, London, Frankfurt, Amsterdam, Vienna and Brussels.
